**Description:** The Office of the Attorney General is seeking applicants for an Assistant Attorney General position in the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU). The MFCU is responsible for investigating and prosecuting criminal cases involving Medicaid fraud by providers and the abuse and neglect of vulnerable adults. The MFCU also investigates and files civil actions under the Maryland Health False Claims Act to recover damages for fraud against the Medicaid program. The MFCU works closely with State and federal law enforcement and health care partners, as well as other MFCUs across the country. Responsibilities for the current position will include criminal investigations and prosecutions throughout the State.

**Experience:** The ideal candidate will have a minimum of five years' criminal litigation experience, excellent investigative and case development skills, and significant trial experience. A background in fraud cases is helpful but not required. Strong abilities in legal research, writing, and oral advocacy are essential. Maryland Bar membership is required.
