The job description of a qualified tax lawyer includes the following criteria:

- Along with excellent communication skills and negotiation ability, a tax lawyer must be able to interact with many people like officials in the corporate tax department, senior people in the finance department of the law firm as well as many officials in the Internal Revenue Service, public accountings and other related firms.
- Handle evaluation, risk assessment and counseling on various complicated tax problems.
- Execute project related tax research and analysis based on Federal and State tax laws.
- Undertake tax basis calculations and other related tax studies.
- Counsel the client on the consequences of new and updated federal and state tax laws that affect the client's business.
- Maintain the tax records and keep up with all filing deadlines related to taxes for the client.
- Along with a JD, you must have substantial financial/accounting experience. CPA, LLM and/or Masters in Tax is a must.
- You need to have contributed substantially in the field of US tax planning, litigation and/or controversy issues, either through publishing, speaking or prior employment.
- Minimum of 4 years practice as an attorney.
