Description: The Office of the Attorney General is seeking candidates for the position of Assistant Attorney General, Police and Correctional Training Commissions, Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services.

The Assistant Attorney General provides legal advice to and conducts training for the Police and Correctional Training Commissions. This person will also represent the Commissions and employees in any litigation.

In addition, the person will handle federal and state litigation related to correctional matters. The litigation responsibilities will include defending tort claims, civil rights actions initiated by inmates and employees, cases arising under the Public Information Act, and actions for judicial review of agency decisions. The position will involve trial and appellate work, and an extensive motions practice.
