Description: The Office of the Attorney General is seeking applicants for a Division Director representing the Maryland State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency (Agency). This position provides advice and counsel on all legal matters and appeals to the Agency as well as the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission (Commission). The position supervises Assistant Attorneys General who provide advice and counsel on a wide variety of gaming law and other issues to the units in the MLGCA and Commission, including but not limited to contract development and negotiations, administrative matters, licensing and revocation issues, intellectual property matters, evidentiary administrative hearings, and Public Information and Open Meetings Act matters. The position directly handles or supervises litigation, including personnel litigation, EEOC complaints, tort cases, procurement disputes and other federal and state court litigation, as well as various intra-office administrative, procurement, public information, and personnel matters. The position is responsible for advising the Agency and Commission on its regulatory responsibilities over traditional Lottery, casino gambling, and other miscellaneous gambling areas such as electronic instant bingo, skills-based amusement devices, online fantasy competitions and – pending approval by statewide referendum – sports betting.

Experience: The ideal candidate must have at least seven years of legal experience; excellent writing and communication skills, and supervisory and litigation experience. Knowledge of boards and commissions and lottery or gaming law is preferred, as is experience in advising clients in a heavily regulated industry. Admission to the Maryland Bar required.
