**Description:** The Office of the Attorney General, State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency, is seeking applicants for a full time Assistant Attorney General responsible for providing advice and legal support to the Maryland State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency (Agency) and the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission (Commission). The Agency and Commission are responsible for regulating, among other things, the State's Casino Gaming, Lottery, and Sports Wagering programs. The Assistant Attorney General will advise the Commission and all divisions of the Agency in their regulatory functions and all ancillary responsibilities. The Assistant Attorney General will primarily provide advice regarding human resources and labor; procurement and contract development, including intellectual property and technology; drafting and enforcing regulations, focusing on licensing requirements for individuals and entities performing regulated functions for: casinos, lottery retail, and sports wagering; the Public Information Act; and the Open Meetings Act. The Assistant Attorney General will also represent the Agency and Commission in litigation before the Office of Administrative Hearings, and State and federal courts.

**Experience:** The ideal candidate will have a minimum of five years of legal experience in government or public human relations and procurement, along with excellent writing, communication, organizational, and analytical skills. Previous government, human resources, and regulatory experience is preferred, but not required. Maryland Bar required.
