Description: The Office of the Attorney General is seeking applicants for Investigators within the newly created Independent Investigations Division. In March 2021, the Maryland General Assembly passed legislation creating an Independent Investigations Division within the Office of the Attorney General. The Division is directed to investigate all alleged or potential police-involved deaths of civilians, and to provide a report containing detailed investigative findings to the State's Attorney of the County that has jurisdiction over the matter. The Investigator position is a unique and exciting opportunity to work with a team of experienced investigators and attorneys, in partnership with the Maryland State Police, who are working together to enhance transparency, strengthen public trust in the criminal justice system, and engage and collaborate with external stakeholders and partners.

Under the supervision of the Division Chief and Chief Investigator, IID Investigators will respond to qualifying incidents in conjunction with the Maryland State Police and local law enforcement agencies, as well conduct aspects of the subsequent investigation. Additionally, the Investigators will ensure that Division standards and protocols are met with the use of sound investigative measures, that evidence is obtained and preserved appropriately, and that all available information is objectively reviewed.

Experience: The ideal candidate will have a minimum of seven (7) years of local, state or federal law enforcement experience in conducting criminal and/or internal affairs investigations to include felony violent crime and/or homicide investigations. Candidates with experience in law enforcement administrative and/or criminal investigations, public corruption, and/or misconduct investigations may include that experience. Experience with high-profile or sensitive investigations is essential, along with excellent interviewing, writing and investigative skills. Candidates should have experience in drafting and executing state and/or federal court orders to include subpoenas and affidavits in support of court orders. Investigators will be required to work on an on-call basis, outside of normal business hours and to travel throughout the State.
