Description: The Office of the Attorney General is seeking applicants for an Assistant Attorney General, Senior Counsel to represent the Maryland Transit Administration (MTA). MTA is a multi-modal transit system, operating Local and Commuter Buses, Light Rail, Metro-Subway, Maryland Regional Commuter (MARC) Train Service and a paratransit system. It owns several freight right of ways and has agreements with several freight carriers operating over those right of ways. This position serves as lead attorney on complex commercial transactions and projects in which the MTA is involved. The Attorney will confer with other transactional attorneys on the substance and strategy of their work while handling his or her own docket of advice and transactional work.

Experience: The ideal candidate will be a member in good standing to the Maryland Bar and have a minimum of seven years' legal experience in handling commercial transactions, such as, procurement and construction contracts, property acquisitions and dispositions or related financing. Experience in transportation, construction, government procurement, public-private-partnerships, or commercial and real estate development is a plus. Applicants must have excellent written and verbal communication skills and strong organizational and interpersonal skills.
