Description: The Office of the Attorney General, Department of General Services, seeks applicants for a full-time Assistant Attorney General with full state benefits to commence July 1, 2022. The Department of General Services (DGS) is charged with the procurement of commodities and services, energy, facilities maintenance, information technology, leased space by the State as lessee, the design and construction of State buildings and the acquisition and disposition of real property interests for the State of Maryland. The Assistant Attorney General for this position will primarily provide advice on real property matters to DGS and the Maryland Department of Agriculture (MDA) and process transactions on behalf of the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation (“MALPF”).

Experience: Candidates should have at least six years of experience in real property practice, with an emphasis on title and conveyancing and at least six years of background experience in real estate transactions. Candidates must have a familiarity with easements and experience in drafting easements is desirable; experience in the closing of real estate transactions and resolving title-related issues; ability to review surveys and identify issues raised in surveys. Candidates should possess competency in Microsoft Office applications, excellent writing skills, work efficiently and accurately on a strict timeline. Candidates must be comfortable interacting with a wide range of people including, without limitation, farmers, attorneys, county administrators, MALPF staff, other AAGs, surveyors and title agents. Title insurance experience is preferred. Knowledge of conservation easement law and issues is very desirable. Familiarity with the MALPF program is also desirable. Awareness of issues regarding mineral rights, utilities, condemnation, railroads, rights of way, and federal tax law regarding charitable donations would be very useful.
