Description: The Office of the Attorney General is seeking applicants for an Assistant Attorney General to serve as Senior Counsel to the Treasurer. The Senior Counsel acts as one of two supervising attorneys for tort claims, who work as a team with shared responsibility for: directly handling particularly complex tort litigation brought against the State under the Maryland Tort Claims Act; directly handling all litigation brought against Maryland Sheriffs and their deputies including, without limitation, both tort and employment related cases; supervising and coordinating the work of dozens of assistant attorneys general assigned to various State agencies who handle the remainder of the State's tort litigation; serving as a resource for assistant attorneys general across the State by, among other things, leading the Office of the Attorney General's Tort Litigation Work Group; providing legal advice and guidance to the Maryland Sheriff's and their deputies as well as the employees of the Insurance Division of the State Treasurer's Office, in each case, with respect to policies and procedures, compliance with state and Federal laws.

Experience: The ideal candidate will be a team player with substantial jury trial and appellate experience and the ability to oversee a large litigation docket, as well as the experience to advise and train assistant attorneys general with varying degrees of litigation experience. Knowledge and experience with the Maryland Tort Claims Act, state government and the representation of law enforcement, while not required, would enhance the candidate's application. Maryland Bar membership is required.
