Focus on admission to college

May assign girls a project to work on including: writing an essay about themselves for college admission, preparing their own step routine, etc.

MARCH 13TH: Special guest Tonya Blount from Sister Act 2 (include showing movie clip). Tonya will discuss her life and ability to overcome domestic violence etc.

MARCH 20TH: "Presenting Self" workshop. Training on how to act, react to life situations, jobs, interviews, meetings, etc. The girls will simulate real life professional situations, including interviewing. Victoria Lanteigne who works at Center for Development and Population Activities as the Senior Associate, Leadership & Capacity Building will assist us in implementing a training that is fun, interactive and educational for the girls. Girls will be assigned a project—e.g. making pins/stickers that reflect how they want to present themselves to the world—

MARCH 27TH: Closing ceremony. The girls will perform a step routine, read essays, and/or explain their pin/stickers.
